New changes that affect your registration renewal

The ACT Government has introduced changes to the ACT Compulsory Third Party Insurance (CTPI) Scheme. One of the reasons for the change is to encourage CTPI competition in the ACT.

From 1 July 2009 new CTPI providers will be able to enter the ACT market.

The ACT Road Transport Authority has changed the registration renewal reminder notice to prepare for the additional CTPI providers. The new reminder notice will provide you with premiums for all CTPI providers licensed to issue CTPI in the ACT. You will be able to select your preferred CTPI provider at the time you renew your registration.

The registration renewal reminder notice asks you to select a CTPI provider, however, only one provider will be available and shown until the approval process is completed for other CTPI providers. Applications are currently being assessed from additional CTPI providers who are seeking to enter the ACT market. Once approved, these providers will be shown on registration renewal reminder notices.
