## Objectives

HealthPACT is a statutory authority established by the *Health Promotion Act 1995*. It is managed by a board of nine members appointed by the Minister for Health and Community Care.

The primary functions of the board include the funding of activities relating to the promotion of good health through sports, arts and community activities and the development of the community's capacity to support its own good health. The major objective of the board is to encourage the development of sustainable structures and opportunities that enable people to make and maintain healthy choices.

## 2000-01 Highlights

Strategic and operational issues to be pursued in 2000-01 include:

- motivating people to make healthy choices;
- adding health promotion value to existing community activity;
- working in priority, and particularly under-resourced areas;
- promoting opportunities to participate in healthy activities and programs;
- developing and promoting partnerships which benefit health promotion;
- providing access to information and research to support health promotion outcomes; and
- supporting innovative and exemplary practice in health promotion.

## Notes to the Budget Statements

Significant variations are as follows:

#### **Operating Statement**

Funding for HealthPACT is provided through legislation at an amount equal to the previous year (\$2.175m) plus indexation based on any positive change in the CPI for the 12 months to March prior to the Budget year. With this funding, the board employs staff, funds community organisations to undertake health promotion programs addressing priority health issues, and undertakes other activities including education, training, research and policy development which support the community in developing and maintaining health.

Funding across the forward years is based on the projected underlying CPI rate of 2.5%.
