Costing Methodology Used:
- Costing Technique:
Treasury has costed this commitment based on the standard on-costs for the staffing levels included in the costing request.
- Proposal Parameters:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The costing assumes a full-time Coroner, to be paid the equivalent salary of an ACT Magistrate, and supporting associate would be appointed from 1 July 2021. • The costing assumes that costs involved in the recruitment and appointment of these positions, along with any other resourcing required, would be absorbed by the Justice and Community Safety Directorate.
Caveats or qualifications to the costing:
This costing only includes the employment of a full-time coroner element from the Canberra Liberals' election announcement <i>Law, Order & Community Safety</i> .
Other Comments:
Treasury's costing differs from that submitted due to the inclusion of motor vehicle allowance and Fringe Benefits Tax allowance for the Coroner.
The salaries of the two positions are from the <i>ACT Remuneration Tribunal Determination for ACT Magistrates Court Judicial Positions</i> (number 8 of 2020) and the <i>Legal Professionals Enterprise Agreement 2018-2021</i> respectively.
