<b>Basis of non-costing:</b>
The announced policy is to make the ACT's entire cycle path network road-free by 2030. Given the uncertainty on the scope of works required to achieve this, it is not possible to cost the policy.
Treasury notes the submitted costing request includes \$500,000 for feasibility and community consultation and considers that the cost estimate for this element in isolation to be reasonable.
