Dwelling Unit Commencements – December Quarter 2023 ABS Release: Building Activity, Australia

Dwelling unit commencements decreased in the December quarter 2023.

Dwelling unit commencements in the **ACT** decreased by 1.0 per cent to 997 commencements (in trend terms) in the December quarter 2023, to be below the five-year average of 1,229 commencements. The fall was driven by both houses and other residential dwellings. Through the year to the December quarter 2023, total commencements decreased by 3.1 per cent.



Nationally, dwelling unit commencements, in seasonally adjusted terms, increased by 1.3 per cent to 38,397 commencements in the December quarter 2023, to be below the five-year average of 46,779 commencements. Through the year to the December quarter 2023, total commencements fell by 6.4 per cent.


Number of and Growth in Dwelling Unit Commencements, Trend, ACT
